



**JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF BENIN**

The Government of the Federated States of Micronesia and the Government of the Republic of Benin,

Desirous of strengthening the friendly relations and developing mutual beneficial cooperation between the two States, for the mutual benefit of their peoples,

Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and International law, particularly on the respect and promotion of international peace and security, equality among States, national sovereignty, independence, international instruments, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of States,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations, in accordance with the provisions of Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961, and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of April 24, 1963, from the date of signing this Joint Communiqué,

In witness thereof, the undersigned representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed in New York, on 14 August 2025, the present Joint Communiqué in two (2) original copies, in English, and French languages, all texts being equally authentic.
