



Joint Communiqué
On the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations
Between
The Government of the State of Qatar and The Government of the
Federated States of Micronesia

The Government of the State of Qatar and the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia,

Desirous to promote mutual understanding and strengthen the friendship and cooperation between their countries,

Guided by the principles of the United Nations charter and international law, particularly the respect and promotion of international peace and security, equality among States, due respect for national sovereignty and territorial integrity, independence and international treaties, and non-interference in the internal affairs of States.

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations with effect from the date of signature of the present Joint Communiqué under the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961 and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 24 April 1963.

In witness thereof the undersigned Representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed the Joint Communiqué in two original copies, in Arabic and English languages, the two texts being equally authentic.

This Communiqué was written and signed in New York City, on 8 June 2026.
